Entrant Instructions

Cooks are expected to:

- Bring a minimum of 6-8 quarts of chili (standard size crock pot). More chili is encouraged and may increase the chance to win (more voters may sample the chili).
- Provide two people per Chili entrant team: one to dispense chili into tasting cups and one to serve the public.
- Provide their own table covering One table will be provided per team.
- Set up your assigned area completely and have chili ready to serve to the public by 5pm (following 4PM Mass). Entrants may begin setting up as early as 2:30pm. Entrants will be asked to clean up their own areas following the event.
- Provide appropriate "themed" decoration of your table. (Related costuming is encouraged.)
- Supply their own crock pot or other method to keep chili heated.
- Electrical will be provided, but if you have extra extension cords/power strips, bring them.
- Bring condiments of their choosing if desired (crackers, cheese, etc.)
- Optional bring additional spices for attendee/voter customization
- Bring their own serving spoon tasting cups and spoons will be provided for attendees/judges.
- Identify which class they are competing in (Vegetarian, Regular, HOT, or Specialty)
- Provide a list of ingredients for display (Feel free to give your chili a name also.)

We will be following all health department guidelines and recommendations for COVID-19. We <u>recommend</u> that masks be worn by everyone while moving around – Please bring your own. Masks may be removed when sitting down to eat only. Entrants are encouraged to bring sanitizer and gloves for their tables for participants to use.

Each entry will receive a number and will be judged by the attendees of the event by number only. Each entry will be evaluated in the following categories: Color, Aroma, Texture/Consistency, Taste and Aftertaste/Bite on a 1 to 10 scale, with 10 being the highest. Each score will be added up, and an average calculated to determine a winner.

The overall winner will receive a cash prize (based on the number of entries), an award and most importantly CHILI BRAGGIN' RIGHTS!
